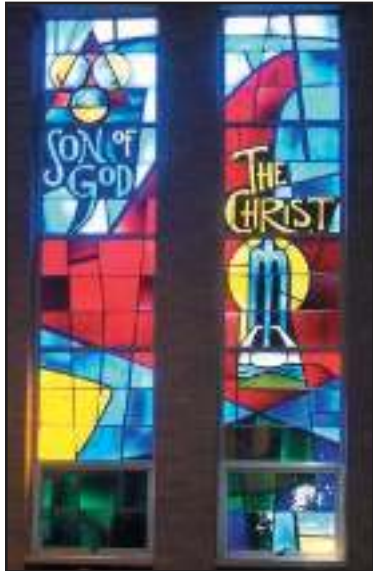

From Your Pastor

Last Sunday on the Solemnity of the Most Precious Body and Blood of Christ, we at Holy Name Catholic Church were graced with the presence of our Shepherd Right Reverend Bishop William D. Byrne in view of administering the Sacrament of Confirmation for our Catechumens of the Class of 2023-2024. Shortly before he did that, he addressed me as follows and I quote directly, " Father John, if I choose you to be a Pastor of Holy Name Church, will you accept? ". In attendance were Deacon John Vennard, Deacon Michael Hodges, Deacon Adalberto Santiago-Martinez, Deacon John Leary the Master of Ceremonies for the Bishop and his wife Donna, Sister Caritina Olmos of the Congregation of Our lady of Perpetual Help, and Sister Leila Sullivan of the Congregation of the Sisters of Saint Joseph. Looking at him intently, this was my response: Yes, My Lordship, I accept with God's help and the support of the people of God here. He proceeded, from this day, you are the PASTOR of Holy Name Church. I responded may God receive the honor and praise as I serve His people in this role. Vesting in the Sacristy we did the procession to the Church. Having kissed the Altar, I said a word of Welcome to the Bishop and the people present. Immediately after this the Bishop greeted us and announced to the people present he is naming me Pastor of Holy Name Church. Spiritual joy and emotion set in on account of this elevation from having been Administrator to now being PASTOR. After this announcement Mass progressed.

Beloved in retrospect I arrived in this Parish last Year on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus 06/16/2023. Our Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Springfield appointed me Administrator of Holy Name Church on 07/01/2023. I hasten to thank every one of you for forming me this far to be the Priest following in the footsteps of our Lord. May the Lord bless you always individually and corporately. The work to build our Parish is immense. I appeal and prayerfully request everyone's active involvement and active participation in the growth of this Church. Doing this together we will be doing the will of the Father with passion and particularly so doing it reverently for the salvation of all.

Please join the clergy, staff and volunteers at the Holy Name Rectory in congratulating Fr. John on this joyous and momentous occasion!! The installation date, time and details will be officially announced once everything has been finalized.

Blessings and congratulations to all of the Confirmandi who received the sacrament of Confirmation at the special mass celebrated by the Most Rev. William D. Byrne last Sunday evening at Holy Name Church.

Eucharistic Adoration: Tuesdays, 1-5p.m., Chaplet prayed at 3p.m., Rosary at 4:30p.m. followed by Benediction. Thank you for your kindness in making sure there is always someone here in church during Adoration time.
