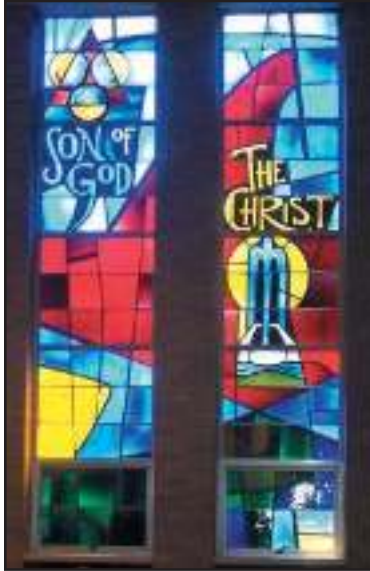

From Your Pastor

This weekend I am intrigued by what I hear from Mark 4:26-34. He makes reference to the parable of the Mustard seed. The latter calls attention to the surprising contrast between the small size of its beginnings and the large shrub it becomes, which is the fruit of its growth. In this parable as well Jesus calls His audience to expect the in-breaking of God's reign into our ordinary daily lives as it unfolds to us at its own time, pace and rate of growth.

So we like disciples are expected to bear fruit by spreading the seeds of faith -namely: the Good news of salvation -and nurture it as best as we can. Then we have to let God go to work. God will eventually reap the harvest and save those who hear His word. The growth has to take place spontaneously and in the proper environment, and if it does, the Kingdom of God will become even bigger than the bush produced by the mustard seed.

In case you missed this announcement in last week's bulletin, please join the clergy, staff and volunteers at the Holy Name Rectory in congratulating Fr. John on this joyous and momentous occasion being named Pastor of our church!! The installation date, time and details are not yet "set in stone", but it is tentatively scheduled for Sunday July 14th at the 10:30a.m. Mass. Fr. John will also receive a blessing at the Spanish Mass, which is scheduled to be moved up to 12noon from the usual 12:30 time. The Spanish Mass will be followed by a reception in the social center which will include food and beverages. The Bishop will be able to meet with both communities right after their respective Masses. We will publish more details once they are firmly in place.

Eucharistic Adoration: Tuesdays, 1-5p.m., Chaplet prayed at 3p.m., Rosary at 4:30p.m. followed by Benediction. Thank you for your kindness in making sure there is always someone here in church during Adoration time.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approximately 10:30a.m. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass to take part.
