



From Your Pastor

Today's Gospel offers us a vibrant look at hope. As I pray with it I have a feeling of awe and amazement. Clearly, I am inspired by the abiding faith of Bartimaeus as he asks Jesus to have pity on him and heal him. Given the most basic invitation to approach Jesus, he springs up. what a demonstration of faith in Jesus. And through his faith in Jesus, he can begin to see.

When do I enthusiastically ask for Jesus to help me? When I am blind to the graces with which God has blessed me? The First Reading from Jeremiah has a beautiful metaphor for our journey with Jesus: With weeping they shall come, but with compassion I will guide them. I will lead them to streams of water on a level road, without stumbling.

As we go about our affairs today, we should all try and focus a little more closely on what we are really seeing and who is in our field of view. Maybe if we look a little closer at the entire picture or try and peer around the corner, we will see Jesus standing there showing us his guiding hand his unfailing willingness to be with us.

STEWARDSHIP

Collective Mass Intentions will be available at Holy Name

Collective intentions, also referred to as "multiple" intentions (at one Mass) are permitted per a notice received from the Diocese of Springfield, Office of the Chancellor. This means that we can accept more than one intention by one family at one Mass. These Masses cannot be celebrated more than twice each week, nor on a feast day. So, **beginning with the first Sunday in November**, which is November 3rd, we will be celebrating Masses with "Collective Intentions" at 10:30a.m. and at the 12:30p.m. Spanish Mass. Those are the Masses that seem to be the most requested, so it would make sense that those are the two where there will be multiple intentions permitted.

Basically, the only difference will be, if you call in to schedule a Mass Intention for Sunday at either 10:30 or 12:30, you will not hear "I am sorry, that Mass is already taken", instead your intention will be accepted. (Note: we do want to keep the number of intentions to 10 or less.) If you need further clarification, please see a priest after Mass or call the rectory office during the week.

The raise in the customary **MASS INTENTION OFFERING** to \$15.00 comes from the bishops of the ecclesiastical province, not from the Bishop of Springfield (canon 952). This applies to new requests and is not retroactive. He asked that we remind people that this is not a price or fee, and that they may offer more, less or even nothing for a requested Mass intention. The \$15.00 limit answers the question, "What is the customary offering?"

We will begin taking calls to sign up for turkeys on Thursday, November 7th after 9a.m.

El Evangelio de hoy nos ofrece una mirada vibrante a la esperanza. Mientras rezo con él, tengo un sentimiento de asombro y admiración. Claramente, me inspira la fe permanente de Bartimeo cuando pide a Jesús que se apiade de él y lo cure. Ante la más elemental invitación a acercarse a Jesús, él se levanta. Qué demostración de fe en Jesús. Y a través de su fe en Jesús, puede empezar a ver. ¿Cuándo pido con entusiasmo que Jesús me ayude? ¿Cuándo estoy ciego a las gracias con las que Dios me ha bendecido? 
