



# From Your Pastor



On Thursday, November 28, at 8:15a.m., we will celebrate our Annual Thanksgiving Day Mass. This has been a long standing tradition at Holy Name Parish. Parishioners are invited to bring food and wine, which will be used at their Thanksgiving Dinner, to be blessed at this Mass.

#### Volunteers needed

to help decorate the church for Advent after the 8:15a..m. Mass on Saturday, November 30<sup>th</sup>. Many hands make light work. Please join us.

Beginning next Sunday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, the Rosary will be said at church each Sunday morning at 10:00a.m.

#### **Eucharistic Adoration Time Change (The day will still be Tuesday)**

With the daylight hours decreasing, the new time is 1-4p.m.

The Chaplet will still be prayed at 3p.m. and the Rosary at 3:30p.m. followed by Benediction.

New Sign-up Sheets are in the church.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approximately 10:30a.m. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass to take part.

When trying to reach a priest in an <u>emergency situation</u> to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.


