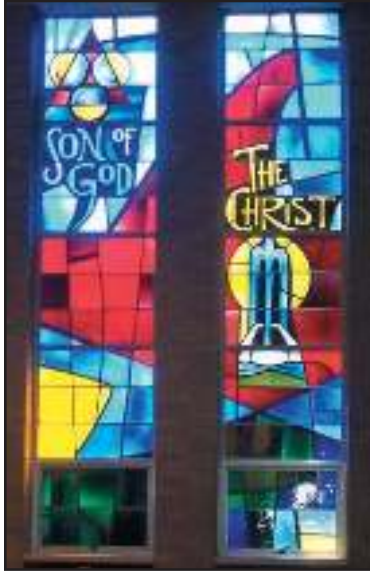

Thanksgiving Service

On Thursday, November 28, at 8:15a.m., we will celebrate our Annual Thanksgiving Day Mass. This has been a long standing tradition at Holy Name Parish. Parishioners are invited to bring food and wine, which will be used at their Thanksgiving Dinner, to be blessed at this Mass.

Volunteers needed

to help decorate the church for Advent after the 8:15a.m. Mass on Saturday, November 30th. Many hands make light work. Please join us.

Beginning next Sunday, December 1st, the Rosary will be said at church each Sunday morning at 10:00a.m.

Eucharistic Adoration Time Change (The day will still be Tuesday)

*With the daylight hours decreasing, **the new time is 1-4p.m.***

The Chaplet will still be prayed at 3p.m. and the Rosary at 3:30p.m. followed by Benediction. New Sign-up Sheets are in the church.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approximately 10:30a.m. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass to take part.

When trying to reach a priest in an **emergency situation** to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.
