## **From Your Pastor**

Reference from today's First Reading we hear Prophet Nehemiah offering us this: Ezra reads plainly from the book of the law to the people gathered, including children who were old enough to understand. As they heard the words Ezra was reading, the people came to realize their sinfulness and began to weep. Yet, Ezra reassured them of God's love. What a powerful reminder to us to listen carefully to the word of God and to always remember the Lord must be our strength. Luke, in today's Gospel, strives to assure Theophilus of the care and accuracy in his account of Jesus reading in the synagogue. Jesus reads from the scroll about His Prophecy, and then simply says: Today the Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing. It would be wonderful if messages were always so clear.

Praying with Ezra reading the law and Jesus reading in the synagogue invites me to examine the Second Reading from Paul to the Corinthians through a new lens. The metaphor that the Church is comprised of many parts of the same body is a favorite Scripture passage and an effective way to open up discussions about community and variety in gifts.

### **Eucharistic Adoration** - 1-4p.m. on Tuesdays

The Chaplet will still be prayed at 3p.m. and the Rosary at 3:30p.m. followed by Benediction.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approximately 10:00a.m. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass to take part.

Al oír las palabras que Esdras leía, el pueblo se dio cuenta de su pecado y se echó a llorar. Sin embargo, Esdras les aseguró el amor de Dios. Qué poderoso recordatorio para nosotros de que debemos escuchar atentamente la palabra de Dios y recordar siempre que el Señor debe ser nuestra fuerza.

Lucas, en el Evangelio de hoy, se esfuerza por asegurar a Teófilo el cuidado y la exactitud en su relato de la lectura de Jesús en la sinagoga. Jesús lee del rollo acerca de su Profecía, y luego dice simplemente: Hoy se ha cumplido el pasaje de la Escritura que has oído. Sería maravilloso que los mensajes fueran siempre tan claros. Rezar con Esdras leyendo la ley y Jesús leyendo en la sinagoga me invita a examinar la Segunda Lectura de Pablo a los Corintios a través de un nuevo lente. 
